Apple Capture and Tool Share

Collecting food from our backyard is easy but it sometimes requires equipment. Wildsight Elk Valley has a growing cooperative tool share program that lets you check out all of the picking, plucking, preserving and pickling equipment you need. Use of the tools is free but we do suggest a donation to keep the tools maintained and available for all to use.
