1. **Due to the short time frame for submissions, we encourage artists to submit pre-existing art pieces using any medium of their choice.*

The deadline for submissions has been extended to Wednesday, September 30th at 4:00 PM.

2. Take a photo of your art piece (unless it is a digital photograph). Please refer to the resources below on how to take a high quality photo of your art:

- 3. Write a 1 page document that includes: title of piece, explanation of the piece, starting bid amount, and a short biography about you, including a headshot photograph of yourself.

- 5. In person art submissions will not be accepted as a precautionary measure due to the ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic.
- 6. Selected artists will be contacted and provided further instructions. Artists of submissions that are not selected will be contacted via email.
- 7. Selected submissions will be dropped off at Centre 64 at a select date and time (TBA) a minimum of 72 hours prior to the opening of the gallery in the first week of October.
