

Reflection and Extension

Camera

Thanks to Nature Through the Seasons teacher Teresa Keenan for this idea!

Pairs of students take turns leading each other to a place they visited during your outing that was special to them. One student is the “photographer” who positions the “camera”(other student) in a position to view something in nature. The photographer pulls on the camera’s earlobe, says click, and then the camera opens their eyes. The pair discuss the scene or object. Do 3-4 times each.

Now use a real camera

Ask students to pick what “photo” was their favourite. Snap a real picture of this spot and use it to add to your classroom visual.

Journaling

Use the special spots the students “photographed” as an inspiration for their journals. Have students sit in this special spot with their nature journals and art supplies and ask them to capture what they see.
