

FERNIE FALL FAIR 2022 ENTRY RULES AND DETAILS

General Rules & Etiquette Entry Categories & Classes

- 1. **Entry Fee:** \$1 per entry. No fee is required to enter the Pie, Cake, and Cupcake categories.
- 2. **Exhibit Registration Times:** All entries must be dropped off on Sunday, September 11th between 9:00-10:30am. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 3. **Location:** The Fall Fair Exhibit and judging takes place at Rotary Park gazebos located at 501 6th A Avenue.
- 4. **Entry Tags:** All entries will be required to fill out a registration form to participate and entry tags for each of their exhibits.
- 5. **Ownership:** All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
- 6. **Judging:** In all cases, the judge's decision is final. Categories may be set up at the discretion of the judges or a class may be subdivided if there are numerous entries. The Danish system of judging is used in this competition.
- 7. **Prizes:** Coloured ribbons are used to indicate the placing in the competition. Each entry is judged against a standard and is given a rating. Each entry will receive a placement ribbon. One first, second, third and participant placing will be awarded per class.
- 8. **Disclaimer:** Neither the Fall Fair Organizing Committee, the City of Fernie, Wildsight, nor Wildsight Elk Valley is responsible for any loss; damage or injury of any nature to property while it is on exhibit. The committee shall take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of all articles.
- 9. **Removal of Entries:** Entries may not be removed from the display until after the event is finished at 2pm. Any articles remaining unclaimed after 3pm on the day of the Fall Fair will become the property of the Fair Committee and Wildsight Elk Valley.
- 10. **Food Safety:** Food items must utilize fresh, local ingredients when possible and be prepared, stored and transported in a food safe manner.
- 11. **Approved containers:** Pies, cupcakes and cakes must be submitted in Fall Fair approved containers to reduce contamination at event. Containers are FREE and may be collected at Local, located at 632 2nd Avenue, before the Sept 10th.
- 12. **Exhibitors:** All ages and abilities are welcome to enter. Participants may enter as an adult, youth, child or family.

Category: PRESERVES

All jars must be in plain, clear glass that are labeled, dated and properly sealed.

Class 12 – Pickles

Category: BAKED GOODS

Class 18 - Pies

Two of the same pies must be entered to qualify. Neither will be returned (1 for pie auction, 1 for judging). Pies must be contained in a Fall Fair approved container (9.5" diameter x 2.5" height) in no larger than a 9" aluminum pan.

Subclass 181 – Fruit

Subclass 182 - Savory

Class 19 - Cakes

All cakes will not be returned (they will be utilized in Cake Walk after judging). Cakes must fit into a Fall Fair approved container - 10" wide and 4.75" high, and fit a cake of maximum 10" width.

Class 20 – Bread

Bread must be entered unsliced in a clear, new bread bag.

Subclass 201 – Yeasted and sourdough

Subclass 202 - Quick

Subclass 203 - Gluten free

Class 21 – Cupcakes

A minimum of 6 cupcakes must be submitted. Cupcakes must be entered in a Fall Fair approved container. All cupcakes will be utilized as part of the Cake Walk after judging and will not be returned. Cupcakes are standard cupcake size and accommodate a high dome.
